In 2010, there were 67.5 turn-related crashes per 100,000 residents. Compare that with New York, which saw just 21.6 per 100,000, and you'll see what we're talking about. (ADOT) Keep Out of the Lane of the Car in Front of You Cars are made to go fast, and sometimes you don't want to go fast. However, keep your vehicle to the right and stay out of the lane of traffic behind the car in front of you. (Just like with buses and trains, giving your car space helps it travel more safely.) Use High Beams If you're in a situation where you have to rely on your high beams, you could miss a turn or drive off the road. And that would be a bad thing. So, turn the beams on before you turn the wheel. Keep a Safe Distance The crash rates of drivers and passengers are extremely different. What that means is, if you're the driver of a vehicle, you're much more likely to be in an accident with an out-of-state driver. Keep a safe distance between your car and the car in front of you. Make a Safe Stop You're more likely to have an accident when you stop. For example, 66.2 percent of drivers involved in crashes didn't make a stop in 2010.
